How to Use this Guide

It's easy to start conversations online with our ready-to-use social media campaign for accident insurance. Use the convenient calendar so you know exactly when to post for best results – or experiment using our guidelines to find what works best for your customers. Just copy and paste the posts and the included graphic for instant, engaging content on your social media channels.

Where to Post

You should post these messages on your existing social media channels – but if you're on multiple platforms, you should consider which audiences you want to reach. **Instagram** users tend to be younger, so it's a good option if you're trying to connect with Millennials or Gen Z customers. If you're aiming for Gen X or Baby Boomers, **Facebook** is the place to go. We don't recommend posting prospecting messages on **X** (formerly Twitter) or **LinkedIn** as they tend to be for news and business networking, respectively.

When to Post

Social media posts tend to do better on weekday mornings, but it depends on which platform you're posting on. Here are the best times and days of the week to post on Facebook and Instagram – you can use the times we recommend in our content calendar, or you can pick from these times and days to find what works best for you.
